Defibrillators


Parish Council are currently investigating the need for additional defibrillators on the outskirts of the village.

On 24/06/2023 21:24hrs, a blue Renault Clio crashed into a wall of a property on the main A4 in Cherhill the vehicle had crashed at high speed and the driver and other occupants had left the scene. Officers search the immediate area using police dogs and the police helicopter. One occupant of the vehicle was taken to hospital to be treated for minor injuries. Enquiries are ongoing regarding this matter.

16/06/2023 12:42hrs, police attended a report of a collision on the Blackland's Road towards the Small grain picnic site involving an Audi A1 and a cyclist. The cyclist sustained fractured to her back and a broken leg. She was taken to hospital for further treatment.

In recent weeks. we have been alerted that electric fences have been removed allowing livestock to roam from their grazing fields in Cherhill and Yatesbury.

This poses a grave risk to motorist and the livestock due to the close proximity to the A4.

Patrols are being completed in the area, but if you see anyone acting in a suspicious manner, please report this on 101 or 999 if appropriate.
